

Beginning July 1st a \$5 gate fee will be applied to every vehicle load entering any Greater Sudbury landfill in addition to regular fees.


The gate was approved by council in the 2024-25 budget.
You can purchase garbage bag tags from your local libraries or Cittizen Service Centres.
They are sold for \$3 each. These tags allow you to leave more than your standard 2 bags at the curb on garbage day! A convenience for many households.

Existing roadside pickups are weekly for blue boxes and bi weekly for green cart, leaf and yard trimmings and 2 garbage bags.


Community Happenings


