This young lady has been an active leader in our community. In the past 2 years she has raised \$1900 for the Northern Ontario Families of Children with Cancer.

Adonia began her pageant path back in 2020 when she was a Jr. contestant in the Miss Teen Onaping Falls Pageant. From there she got the pageant fever and began a wonderful journey into larger competitions. In 2023 she was crowned Miss Teen Greater Sudbury to be followed this June by her new title, Miss Teen Ontario Regional Canada 2024. She says 'Starting this journey was exciting and filled with glamour, self confidence and self expression. I am so grateful to embrace every opportunity given to me.'

She is confident and solid in her platform supporting The Bipoc Plan and she is honoured to be a voice for other BIPOC Youth, a member of the Youth Advisory Council with Compass and an Indigenous Liaison to BLM in Greater Sudbury.

Adonia is currently writing a first-person column with CBC Kids on how she pursued advocacy through pageantry. Part of her summer will be spent as an accepted participant in the Gord Downie & Chanie Wenjack (DWF) Youth Ambassador Program. This 4 week leadership training program engages 100 indigenous and non indigenous youth online in part time work that will support them to become champions of reconciliation in their schools and communities.

This young lady is going places. Her intelligence and compassionate character will lead her to a grand future! Good luck to Adonia. You do our community proud!

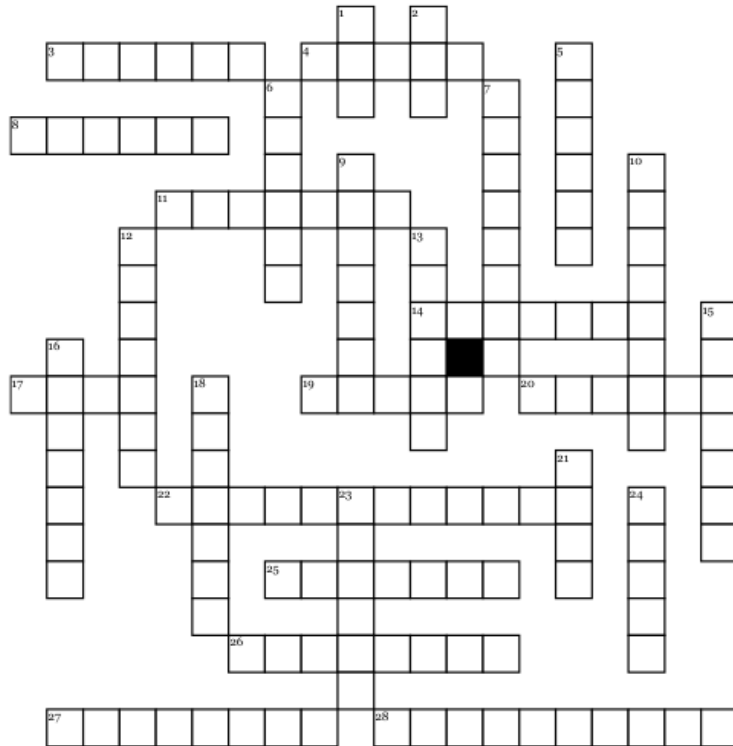

## CITY OF GREATER SUDBURY IMPLEMENTS GATE FEE AT ALL LANDFILL SITES



Beginning July 1st a \$5 gate fee will be applied to every vehicle load entering any Greater Sudbury landfill in addition to regular fees.

The gate was approved by council in the 2024-25 budget.

You can purchase garbage bag tags from your local libraries or Citizen Service Centres. They are sold for \$3 each. These tags allow you to leave more than your standard 2 bags at the curb on garbage day! A convenience for many households.

Existing roadside pickups are weekly for blue boxes and bi weekly for green cart, leaf and yard trimmings and 2 garbage bags.

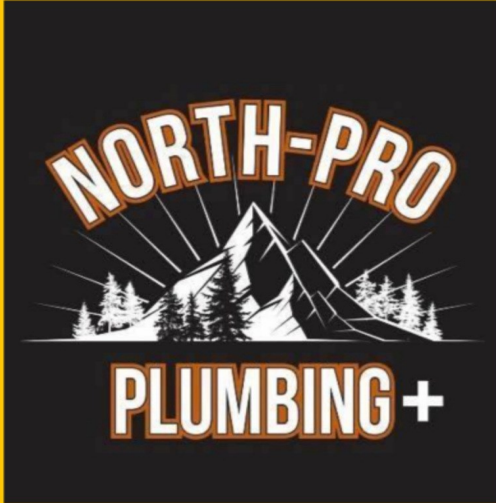

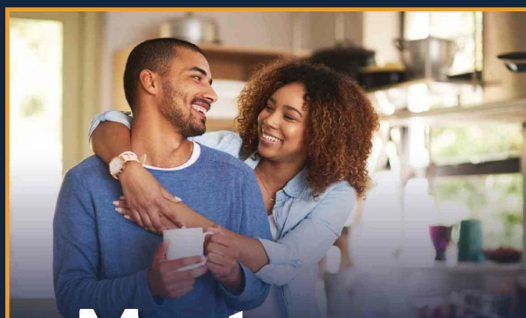

They are out there all the time and you never know when you might see an "Ah ha" moment taking place.

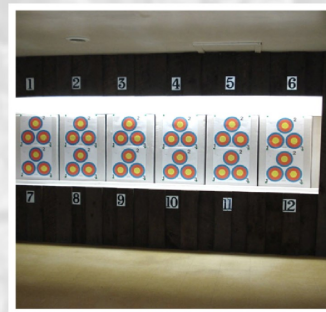
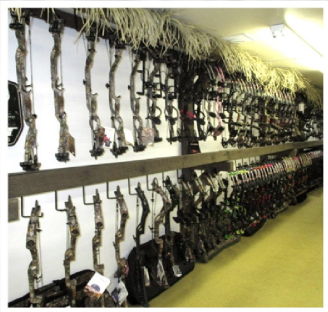

She always taught the importance of reading to her students.

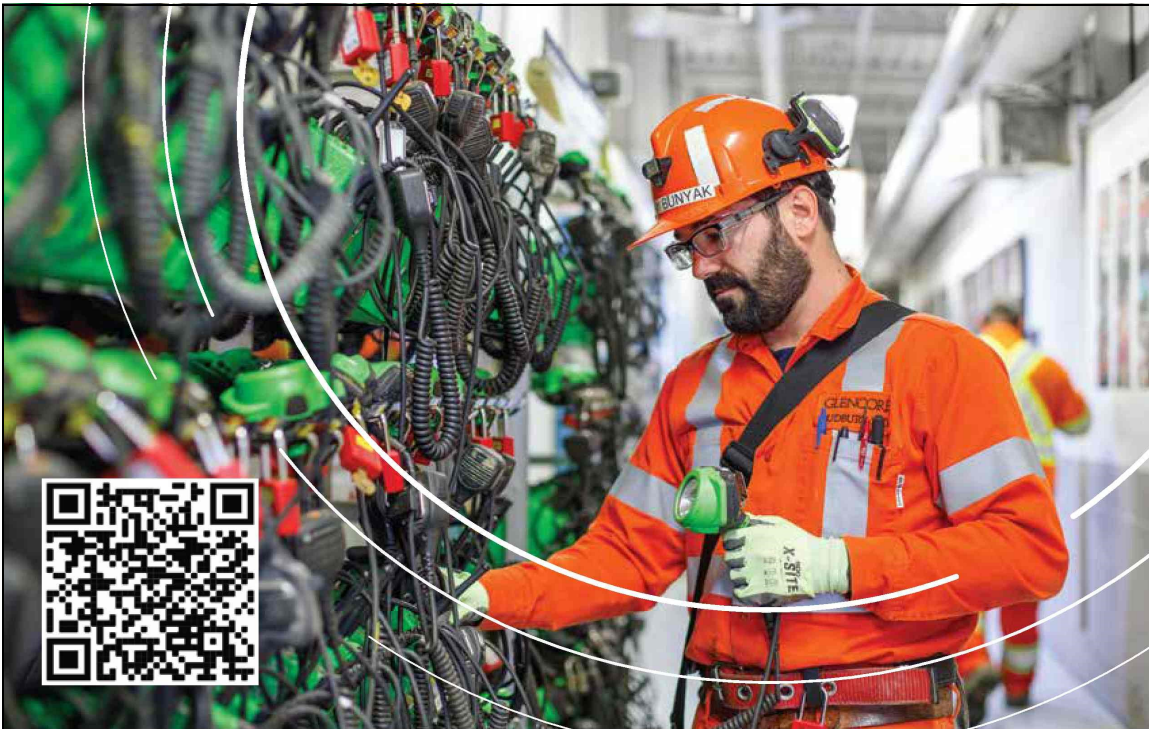
After she passed away in 2011 her family set forth an annual 'Reading Award' to students at Larchwood Public School.
