

October was an other busy month for our Lions. Winding down from another fabulous Cavalcade of Colours we set right in to our weekly Bingos and Euchre.


Halloween Bingo was a full house! Thank you to all that attended and dressed up for the evening!

The Onaping Falls High Riders is the local snowmobile club in the Dowling, Levack, Onaping and Cartier area. We have over 120 kms of trails starting near the Fairbanks Lake area and ending North of Hanmer.

Volunteers are the backbone of the Club and help ensure we have world class trails for the enjoyment of riders. 
